From April 2019 RNZ National will no longer be available on AM radio frequencies in Central Otago when RNZ's two aging AM transmitters are closed down.

Current listeners will need to switch to an FM frequency or select from several alternative listening options to keep receiving RNZ National programming. No services apart from RNZ National delivered on AM radio frequencies are affected.

Important message for RNZ National listeners in Central Otago



Why are the changes being made?

RNZ's AM broadcasting transmitters are old and increasingly expensive to maintain. Listenership on AM radio is declining in favour of new technologies and there are now many alternative ways of listening to live radio, including on existing FM radio frequencies, via digital platforms and on mobile devices.

How do I keep listening?

Most listeners will simply re-tune to 101.5 FM or 101.6 FM to receive RNZ National.

What if I can't get FM?

Some existing listeners may be outside the FM coverage area and will need to select a different option for continuing to receive RNZ National.
